ORTEX is a global financial data and analytics company. It produces the short interest and cost-to-borrow estimates, the financial press quotes, alongside options analytics, trading signals, fundamentals and real-time news across global markets. The same data runs the ORTEX platform, the API and Python SDK, and a native Excel add-in.

What we cover

- Short interest and cost-to-borrow estimates, updated through the trading day
- Options analytics, implied moves and positioning
- Trading signals and the ORTEX Stock Score
- Fundamentals, estimates and an EPS-vs-price divergence signal
- Index-rebalance predictions and estimated passive flows
- Real-time, deduplicated news across global equities, ETFs, FX and commodities

How it is delivered

On the ORTEX platform (web and mobile), through a documented REST API and Python SDK, and as a native Microsoft Excel add-in. The same numbers reach analysts, quant pipelines and spreadsheets without re-keying.

Institutions, quant funds, professional traders and individual investors worldwide use ORTEX for research, risk and idea generation. When short interest makes headlines, ORTEX estimates are often the figures quoted: they appear in reporting by Reuters, Bloomberg and financial media around the world.
